



### **ICS-100 Course (Incident Command System)**

It is recommended that all volunteers take the ICS-100 course (Incident Command System) as this is the structure that is used in an emergency event. An ICS enables integrated communication and planning by establishing a manageable span of control. It basically allows for you to receive instructions from a single person as well as report to a single person.

You can access this course through the link below, however it is suggested that you set up an account on the MRC-train site and take it through there. On the MRC-train site, search ICS-100 and choose the ICS provided by FEMA. Once it comes up, click register and then launch the course.
